The Bureau County Clerk's office is responsible for the processing of claims against Bureau County, is Secretary of the Bureau County Board, conducts elections in Bureau County, is acting Registrar of Vital Records for events occurring in Bureau County, compiles tax information and rates for property taxes, and is the Recorder of Deeds for property transfers occurring in Bureau County.

The Bureau County Clerk's office consists of 7 full time employees including the County Clerk and the current annual budget is \$242,817.
